## SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The school is required to submit a proposal or complete the online registration form recommending a single girl student to the foundation.
2. The proposal must bear the signature of the school principal/headmaster/headmistress. For online registration, the form should be filled out by the representative of the Principal.
3. The recommended student must be a current student in classes 2nd to 10th.
4. The student should have attained a minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grades in the preceding academic year.
5. The school must furnish a copy of her previous year's report card duly certified by the principal to the foundation along with the application form.
6. During the selection process, a copy of the EWS certificate and the Mark-sheet of the previous class may be required.
7. Proposals must be submitted to the Foundation no later than October 31, 2023. Each selected student will receive a scholarship by February 2024, disbursed directly to their school address.
8. A special committee appointed by the SilverZone Foundation will assess all received proposals.
9. Decisions made by the committee are conclusive and binding.
10. Any disputes concerning the scholarship will be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi.
